

Water Expert Group (WEG) was mandated to elaborate:


- A long term Strategy for Water in the Mediterranean (SWM)
- A Draft Action Plan

UfM and WEG members: 43 states of the UfM (EU countries, Balkan countries, North Africa countries and countries of Near East) + European Commission + League of Arab States + Libya as observer

During the IV Euro-Mediterranean Ministerial Conference on Water held in Barcelona on 13 April 2010, it was not possible to formally adopt the SWM due to outstanding political considerations. **Adoption is pending**.

At the Ministerial:


agreement of 99% in the Draft Strategy (being the outstanding political Considerations of two references in the text).



Major outcomes of the SWM process:

- A close collaboration among all UfM partners, which has enriched the work for developing the different tasks
- A high participative approach was followed, counting on the expertise of water stakeholders including the civil society
- The widespread acknowledgement of the joint technical work

Possible Process for the Preparation of the Action Plan

Suggested overall process for preparation of the Draft Action Plan:

- A recommendation by WEG 4 Meeting (18 May 2011)
- Approval by the UfM Senior Officials (May/June 2011)
- Technical preparatory work from June 2011 to June 2012
- Approval by Ministerial Conference in November (indicative) 2012

Suggested technical mechanism to prepare the draft Action Plan, based on existing structures and work modes:

- The Water Expert Group (WEG) is the key technical body responsible for discussing and agreeing on drafts. Two WEG meetings are foreseen.
- A Technical Drafting Group (TDG), among other activities, engages in the technical preparation of Draft. Three TDG meetings are foreseen.
- Preparation of Draft Action Plan's chapters is lead by TDG countries and possible technical assistance by regional partners (e.g. EIB on water financing). Donors are expected to have a considerable input.
- Informal technical input is welcome by regional stakeholder organisations
- The process is technically coordinated by the UfM Secretariat with continuing technical assistance from MED EUWI Secretariat

Possible Process for the Preparation of the Action Plan

Suggested timeframe:

In 2011 (tentative)

- May: WEG 4 mandates TDG
- May/June: Mandate from the UfM Senior Officials
- June: Preparation of draft ToR for the Action Plan
- July: Organisation of TDG AP 1 to discuss draft ToR and distribution of tasks
- July: Approval of ToR by WEG (through e-mail process)
- September to December: Technical drafting of the Action Plan's chapters
- Early December: Organisation of TDG AP 2 to consolidate a Draft 0 based on material prepared
- Informal stakeholder meetings and conferences may be organised to provide input to the process

Possible Process for the Preparation of the Action Plan

Suggested timeframe:

In 2012 (tentative)

- January: Preparation of Draft 1 of the Action Plan
- Beginning February: Organisation of WEG 5 to review progress & discuss Draft 1
- February to April: Advance Draft 2 of the Action Plan
- End April: Organisation of TDG AP 3 to consolidate Draft 2 (Final)
- May: Preparation of Final Draft
- Mid June: Organisation of WEG 6 to discuss and agree Final Draft
- End June: Disseminate final Draft for comments and approval in related bodies
- July to October: Comments and approval by related bodies
- November (indicative): Organisation of Ministerial Conference to approve Action Plan
- Informal stakeholder meetings and conferences may be organised to provide input to the process
