





HIGH-LEVEL MEETING INVESTING IN THE GREEN TRANSITION: A MEDITERRANEAN OUTLOOK

Cairo, 04 October 2021 – 14:30 – 16:30 (CET)

Context

As we recover from the COVID-19 crisis, we will seek to build back better and greener. This is even more urgent for the Mediterranean, one of the regions in the world hardest hit by the impact of climate change and environmental degradation. All Mediterranean countries have a clear common interest in taking action now. They also have a considerable potential to mitigate the drivers of climate change and environmental degradation, including through an accelerated transition to low emission, resource efficient economies. Accelerating public and private financial flows towards sustainable policies and investments fostering a solid green transition will be critical to collectively deliver on our global sustainability agenda. Climate finance and sustainable investments will be essential to help recover better and create a more inclusive society, so that everyone can play their part.

This event will look into trends, opportunities and tools to accelerate the green transition in the Mediterranean. It will be the first of a series of dialogues on sustainable investments and green transition that will bring together policy makers, the business community, the financial sector and other stakeholders to exchange views on how to drive the transition towards clean, equitable and competitive economies in the Mediterranean.

Format

The high-level dialogue will be held in a hybrid format. Participants will include senior officials and policy makers of the Union for the Mediterranean, members of the UfM working group on environment and climate change, as well as representatives of partner organizations, private sector, and civil society organizations.
