





Union for the Mediterranean and AFAEMME promote entrepreneurship among young women university students

The project *Young Women as Job Creators*, promoted by the Association of Organizations of Mediterranean Businesswomen (AFAEMME) and endorsed by the 43 Member States of the Union for the Mediterranean (UfM), will be implemented between May and November 2013 in Morocco, Palestine, Jordan and Spain. The project intends to inform, motivate and train about 10.000 young women university students in the four participating countries to become future successful businesswomen and employers.

The project promotes self-employment and entrepreneurship among young women university students who are about to graduate from a university and who have an interest in starting their own business. By facilitating the transition of these young, talented women from education to work, the project advocates a stronger role of women in the social and economic development of the region, additionally contributing towards gender equality in the Mediterranean.

The project's core events are **Women Entrepreneurship Days** (WEDs). They will consist of seminars which will provide the participants with specific training and coaching to create new businesses. They will be hosted by local universities, faculties, businesswomen associations and partner institutions. With an estimated 10.000 participants in the four countries, concrete advice and steps towards business creation will be provided to an estimated number of 400 most motivated young women.

The WEDs will consist of:

- SEMINARS about self-motivation and motivation, key points for setting up a company, key legislative issues, national entrepreneurship incentives system, business planning with a gender perspective and coaching for entrepreneurship.
- EXCHANGES with successful national businesswomen (Role Models).
- NETWORKING ENCOUNTERS with students, entrepreneurs and businesswomen.
- TALENT SEARCH CONTEST (European Investment Bank internships). Yet to be confirmed.

The participants who already have a business idea will have free access to the business creation advice services offered by the four collaborating national Businesswomen Associations (Association of Moroccan Businesswomen AFEM, Business and Professional Women International Ramallah Club BPWRC, Catalan Association of Business and Executive Women ACEE, and Jordan Forum for Business and Professional Women JFBPW). The participants will receive support in formulating a Business Plan, accessing finance and other key issues related to start-ups. While being able to directly benefit from successful







businesswomen's advice and experience, these young and motivated women will receive strong support and acquire knowledge and skills needed to transfer their enormous potential and talent into concrete women-owned businesses.
