- Create a rating tool of socio-economic indicators to measure the inclusiveness of investment projects associated with a label (EDILE label);
- Reinforce the capacities of national and local authorities involved in the regulation of investment;
- Support enterprises in enhancing the social and economic impact of their investment projects.
