Description of the Side Events:

REGIONAL DIALOGUE ON WOMEN EMPOWERMENT, 9 OCTOBER 2018

The UfM dialogue on women empowerment, between governments and the concerned stakeholders, has started in 2015 with the objective to review countries and stakeholders' engagements in the Euro-Mediterranean and to provide recommendations for the policy makers to advance gender equality agenda in the region. "Women Economic Participation", "Combating violence against women" and "the role of women in peace and security agenda" are three of the four priority areas agreed with countries to be topics of the dialogue.

The event will be the first review meeting after the adoption of the UfM fourth Ministerial Declaration on strengthening the role of women in society, adopted during the Ministerial meeting held in Cairo, Egypt on 27 November 2017 and we expect it to validate the indicators for the follow-up mechanism foreseen in the Declaration.

• WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS' FORUM: PROMOTING WOMEN BUSINESS PARTNERSHIP IN THE MEDITERRANEAN, 9-11 OCTOBER 2018

Organized in partnership with UNIDO, The Forum will be the business window of the Conference. The 2018 edition aims at building skills, connecting and empowering female entrepreneurs to start, grow and sustain their enterprises in a competitive environment that will lead towards a direct impact on the economy as well as the entrepreneurial ecosystem. The forum's agenda will include B2B networking, product and business concept exhibition and specific panels and keynote addresses with participation of high-level business experts and policy makers that will offer knowledge and advice on various business opportunities, good practices and success stories in doing business in the areas of ICT and food sector applying innovative technologies.

• EURO-MEDITERRANEAN YOUTH FORUM SHAPING THE DIGITAL FUTURE, 9-11 OCTOBER 2018

After the success of last year's youth forum co-organized by Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung's and UfM, the Euro-Mediterranean Youth Forum 2018 aims at providing young participants, coming from the Euro-Mediterranean countries, with a platform to present and discuss their perceptions and ideas, innovative practices and experiences with Digital Transformation. The overall objective of the forum is to provide recommendations to the UfM women conference's participants regarding Digital Transformation and how young women and men can become involved and engaged in shaping our digital future. Youth forum participants will have the opportunity to attend the 4th UfM women conference and present the youth's recommendations to the conference participants at the final plenary session on the 11th October. The forum's report and final recommendations will be published in the conference report.

• WOMED – WOMEN OF THE MEDITERRANEAN: NEXT GENERATION OF LEADERS, 9 OCTOBER 2018

WoMED is an innovative high-level training program on women empowerment and gender equality conducted by Sciences Po Paris from 2015-2017 with the support of the French Ministry of European and Foreign affairs, the French Ministry for Women Rights and the Inter-ministerial delegation for the Mediterranean. The WoMED project was labelled by the UfM in 2015 and is part of the UfM Secretariat's global strategy to promote concrete projects for women empowerment and gender equality in the Euro-Mediterranean region. For three successive years, 62 women aged 25 to 35 years old, coming from Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine, Syria, Turkey or Tunisia, pursued an intensive training program on leadership and gender equality, with a twofold objective: how to disseminate gender equality principles in the Mediterranean region and how to be part of a lively leading women network.

For the first time Sciences Po will gather all the WoMED participants for an in person one-day event to share their field experiences, reflect upon the impact of the training and brainstorm on their role in building inclusive societies for the Mediterranean. It will be the occasion for them to consolidate their network and launch an internet platform.

• COMMITTEE ON WOMEN'S RIGHTS OF THE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY OF THE UFM, 11TH OCTOBER 2018

The Committee on women's rights deals with the situation of women on both sides of the Mediterranean and with their participation in the political, economic, social and cultural spheres. It discusses issues related to gender equality, the protection of women's rights, the prevention of discrimination, the access of women to education and the labour market and women and the mass media. The Committee also deals with the role of women in the democratisation process and the governance in the Euro-Mediterranean region.

• ROUND TABLE: BEHAVIOURAL INSIGHTS FOR WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT, 11TH OCTOBER 2018

Organized in partnership with the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) Regional Hub for the Arab States, the half-day side event will be focused on the use of behavioural insights as a tool for fostering women's economic empowerment in the Arab region.

Behavioural insights draw on diverse disciplines such as behavioural economics and neuroscience to explain human behaviour and decision making. For the past several years, UNDP has been experimenting with behavioural insights to lead to better diagnosis of challenges and better design of policies and programmes, in areas such as gender-based violence, healthcare, and environment. Behavioural insights are increasingly being

used in the context of entrepreneurship, both to develop effective entrepreneur ecosystems (macro level) and to support individual entrepreneurs (micro level).

The side event will be an opening discussion of behavioural insights followed by a hands-on immersion into how they can be used to address the challenges to women's economic empowerment in the Arab region and to create a path to success for women and young women entrepreneurs. Special speakers will be several policy makers, entrepreneurs and young women entrepreneurs from UNDP's Youth Leadership Programme, a regional initiative that promotes innovation for sustainable development; their experiences will be the basis for the hands-on activity during the session. We invite policy makers, entrepreneurs, development actors and others to join us in this interactive session. The event will be facilitated by innovation for development experts from UNDP and its partners.
