The “TransLogMED” regional project will foster regional integration and a more efficient Euro-Mediterranean transport and logistics sector by promoting sustainable transport connectivity chains, door-to-door logistics, intermodal solutions as well as enhancing the competencies of ports, logistics operators and transport administrations through certified training and knowledge-transfer programmes, over a 5-year period. Ultimately, the project will contribute to the development of an efficient, interoperable and sustainable transport infrastructure network in the Euro-Mediterranean region.

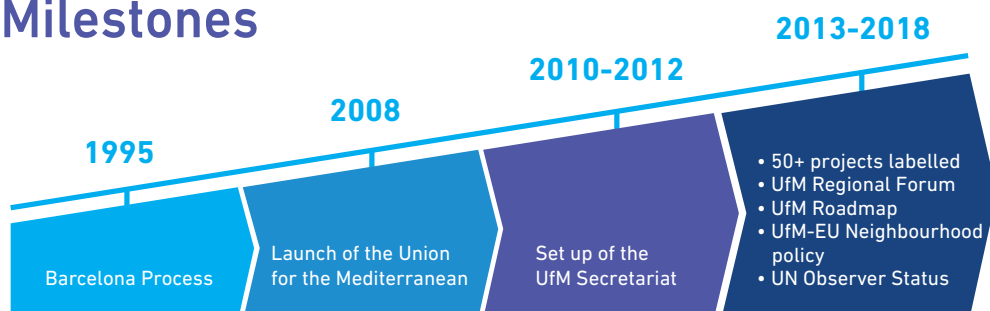
