### About the event

Coinciding with the **25th Anniversary of the Barcelona Process** adopted in 1995, and the 25th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and its Platform for Action, the 2020 Women4Mediterranean Conference intends to serve as a milestone to appraise and take stock of what has been achieved over the past 25 years, to learn from what has worked and to further identify areas that require improvement. The COVID-19 pandemic has changed the scenario. Preliminary data shows that **the pandemic is deepening pre-existing gender inequalities**, exposing vulnerabilities in social, political and economic systems which are in turn **amplifying the impacts of the pandemic on women and girls' lives**. All these impacts are further intensified in contexts of fragility, conflict, and emergencies where social cohesion is already undermined, and institutional capacity and services are limited.

The Conference seeks to **further analyse the impact of the COVID-19 crisis on women and girls and to highlight the key role played by women in addressing the pandemic**. It also aims to identify what is needed to better value the role of women and foster women's participation in policy and decision-making to address the pandemic. This year's event will also witness the launch the UfM Institutional Ministerial follow-up mechanism and its indicators, which will be adopted this year by the UfM Member States and will allow to monitor and measure gender equality progress in the region and provide policy and actions-oriented recommendation to close the gender gap.

### The conference will focus on the following themes:

- women on the frontline of COVID-19
- women's economic participation and the impact of COVID-19
- ending violence against women and girls
- mainstreaming gender in recovery responses of agri-food sectors and rural areas
- gender Equitable Leadership in the Global Health Workforce
- the role of women managing the pandemic at local and regional level
- the Role of Youth in Combating Gender Stereotypes
