







## AD-HOC MEETING OF THE DRAFTING GROUP OF THE MINISTERIAL DECLARATION ON WATER IN THE MEDITERRANEAN

## Malta, 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> February 2025

## **CONCEPT NOTE**

## Background

The First UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water took place in Malta on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2017. It resulted in the approval of the Ministerial Declaration of the UfM Water Ministers on the UfM Water Agenda. The Declaration mandated the UfM Regional Platform on Water (then known as the Water Expert Group, which was created at the 2008 Water Ministerial Conference) to elaborate and implement the UfM Water Agenda, and an accompanying financial strategy, through a medium/long term work programme and biannual work plans. In the Declaration, Ministers agreed to reconvene, in principle, in two years to review progress on the development of the UfM Water Agenda.

At the 14<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the UfM Regional Platform on Water (Lisbon, June 2024), UfM member states strongly supported the need for a new UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water to provide high-level political orientation to the work on water carried out around the Mediterranean. At this meeting of the Regional Platform, Morocco reiterated its offer to host the Second UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water.

After meeting, the UfM Secretariat, in consultation with the co-Presidencies, developed a *Concept for the organisation of the Second UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water and the Development of a Ministerial Declaration on Water*. Following the Senior Officials Meeting (SOM) of 26 September 2024, the UfM Senior Officials supported the organisation of the Second UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water in principle at the end of 2025.

The main output of the Second UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water will be the *UfM Ministerial Declaration on Water in the Mediterranean*. The Ministerial Declaration will be a short document setting out the ambition and priorities for achieving the water-related SDGs in the Mediterranean. The time scope of the Ministerial Declaration will be the period 2026-2030. The Ministerial Declaration will be an input to the UN 2026 Water Conference that will take place at the UAE on 2-4 December 2026.

The development of the Ministerial Declaration will follow the guidance recently issued under the UfM Reform process (see the document *Reform Package 1 – organisational aspects*). In particular, a first draft of the Ministerial Declaration will be prepared by end February 2025 and an advanced draft will be presented for discussion in a multi-stakeholder setting at the next meeting of the UfM Regional Platform on Water in early June 2025.

#### **Objectives**

The overall objective of the meeting is to kick-start the process of drafting a new Ministerial Declaration on Water in the Mediterranean.

The specific objectives of the meeting are:

- to recall the concept of the Second UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water,
- to discuss and seek agreement on the selection of host country the Second UfM Ministerial Meeting on Water,
- to present and discuss a Draft Outline of the Ministerial Declaration on Water,
- to present and discuss inputs provided by individual Member States,
- to provide updates on the preparation of the three policy documents that will be part of the Ministerial Package, and
- to present the concept of the Ministerial Meeting and the Ministerial Declaration to regional stakeholders and seek their feedback.

## Participation in the meeting

The meeting will include two parts. The first day of the meeting, participation will be limited to representatives of UfM member states. The second day of the meeting (half-day) participation will be open to include regional stakeholders.

## **Meeting output**

The Co-Presidencies and the UfM Secretariat will draft a summary of the meeting and share it will all members of the UfM Regional Platform on Water (RPWater).

Following the meeting, the UfM Secretariat, in consultation with the Co-Presidencies, will develop a full First Draft of the Ministerial Declaration by end of February. This will be shared with all RPWater members and written comments will be requested by the end of March.

The UfM Secretariat, in consultation with the Co-Presidencies, will develop, by mid-May, a Second Draft incorporating the written comments received, and will distribute it for discussion at the 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the UfM Regional Platform on Water in early June 2025 (location tbc).
