Question 1: As part of the planned activities and expected outputs detailed in sections 4.1.2. and 4.1.3. of the ToR, could you please clarify whether the expectation is to develop a web-based tool (including the IT components of it), or rather to develop an interactive document (e.g., interactive Excel or decision tree) that a team of developers at UfM will subsequently integrate into a web tool?

Answer: The expectation is to develop an interactive document-based toolkit rather than a fully web-based platform with integrated IT components. This means that the toolkit will consist of structured decision trees, interactive Excel tools, and templates that will provide clear and practical guidance for project developers.

The designed toolkit will allow UfM's internal team to later adapt and integrate it into a digital platform if needed. However, at this stage, the contractor's role is to focus on content, methodology, and usability to ensure that the toolkit is structured, user-friendly, and aligned with regional project development needs. Any web-based development or IT implementation will be handled separately at a later stage by UfM's technical team.
