












### NSIWRM 2018-2027 OBJECTIVES

#### NATIONAL STRATEGY FOR INTEGRATED WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT (NSIWRM) 2018-2027

1st OBJECTIVE

• Water Quantity: ensuring a fair and sustainable use of all water resources, that serves all interests through the application of national legal acts and sub-acts, which transpose the relevant EU directives

2<sup>nd</sup> OBJECTIVE

• Water Quality: ensuring good water quality of all water resources, achieving the status of "good water status" by 2027, through the application of national legal acts and by-laws, which transpose the relevant EU directives

3<sup>rd</sup> OBJECTIVE

• Water Risks: reduction of water risks (floods and droughts) through management and investment, which serves all interests, along with the application of national legal acts and by-laws, which transpose the relevant EU directives

4<sup>th</sup> OBJECTIVE

• Water Information: generally recognized trustworthy water and climate data and models are secured for all stakeholders, and adequate policy advice based on these data and models is provided to government by relevant institutional data owners

5<sup>th</sup> OBJECTIVE

• Water Governance: water is managed in a sustainable and inclusive way, serving all interests, providing equal water related socio-economic benefits and involvement in decision making for future generations, according to IWRM and EU environmental water policy principles




#### Status of RBMPs in Albania

The situation of drafting the RBMPs in Albania


Currently, we have 5 RBMPs approved by the Council of Ministers.



For the sub-chapter Water Quality, the competent authority

- AMBU leads the preparation of Negotiation Positions for Chapter 27.
- Albania has made substantial progress in water management by aligning its water policies and legislation with the EU acquis.



ACCESSION NEGOTIATIONS in the area of water quality are conducted within CLUSTER 4 / Chapter 27 (Environment and Climate Change).

- This process provides inputs towards meeting the EU (environment and water) acquis requirements and identifies gaps in the EU approximation process which the GoA and AMBU need to address.
- Chapter 27 is one of the costliest chapters for implementation of the EU acquis.
- EU4RIVERs supports AMBU with the preparation of different Directive Specific Implementation Plans (DSIPs).
