# WHY A NEW VISION?

30 years after the Barcelona Process, the Mediterranean stands at a turning point. The region faces increasingly complex and interconnected challenges – from climate change and instability to economic fragmentation and social divides – that no country can address alone. To respond, the Union for the Mediterranean (UfM) is launching a renewed vision as the region's unique platform for dialogue, confidence-building and collective action.

At its heart lies connectivity – the idea that the Mediterranean's stability, inclusion and prosperity depend on stronger connections between people, countries and economies. Consistent with the EU Pact for the Mediterranean with the EU Pact for the Mediterranean, this vision seeks to safeguard stability, foster cooperation, and deliver tangible regional benefits.

The UfM promotes joint action on climate, water, energy, and food security. It supports sustainable resource management, disasterrisk reduction, and civil protection, fostering dialogue to ease tensions and secure peace dividends through practical collaboration.

### CONNECTING ECONOMIES

The UfM advances regional integration through trade, investment, and cross-border cooperation. Working with international partners, it promotes investment, and digital transformation through shared infrastructure and responsible innovation.
