TAXI

You will find a taxi rank outside any of the main terminal exits Terminal 1 (T1) or Terminal 2. Taxis operate all night. Taxi fare: approx. 35€

AEROBUS

The Aerobus service is an express bus service that links Barcelona airport to the city centre. You can catch the Aerobus from outside both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, where they are clearly indicated and easily recognisable by their white & blue colour. This service normally leaves each terminal every 6 minutes. The Aerobus will then take you to the city centre.

BY CAR / PARKING

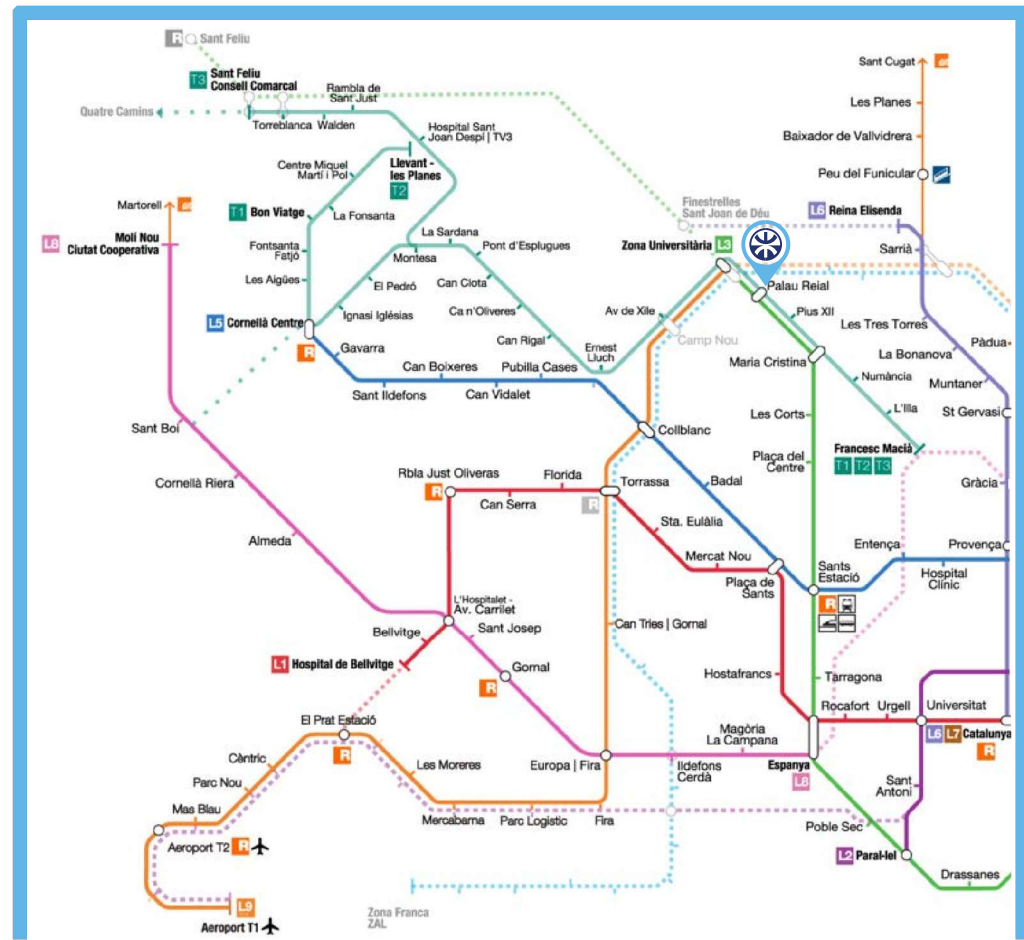
Only Cars with drivers and taxis are allowed access to the UfMS premises. Parking is forbidden for all within the premises, but there are two parking close to the venue:

METRO

Barcelona has an efficient metro system making it quick and easy to travel through the city. Line 9 connects the Airport to the Palacio de Pedralbes. (Price: 5,70€ - Time: 50 minutes).

The metro station close to the UFM is “Palau Reial”.

Visa Requirements

Climate

The average annual temperature is 20° C during the day and 11° C at night. Although temperatures may fluctuate in different seasons: During summer, the average temperature remains 20° - 28°. December, January and February are the coldest months, with average temperatures of 14° C during the day and 5° C at night.

Time Zone

Like most states in Europe, Summer (Daylight – Saving) Time is observed in Spain Time, where the time is shifted forward by 1 hour; 2 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+2). After the summer months the time in Spain Time is shifted back by 1 hour to Central European Time (CET) or (GMT+1).

Electrical current

Voltage is 220 Volts – European Outlets (50 Hz)
